We receive, hold and process information relating to individuals ('personal data') in accordance with Data protection best practice. In doing so, the company is committed to maintaining the privacy and protection of all personal data collected in pursuance of its services. As a company we are further committed to ensuring that our website is secure in the collection and use of your personal information.

INFORMATION WE MAY COLLECT FROM YOU

When you subscribe to our CleverLaw.co.uk service we will collect and process personal information about you which may include the following:

Information you give to us. DISCLOSURE OF YOUR INFORMATION

Analytics and search engine providers that assist us in the improvement and optimisation of our site. We may disclose your personal information to third parties:

If CleverLaw.co.uk or substantially all of its assets are acquired by a third party, in which case personal data held by it about its customers will be one of the transferred assets.

If we are under a duty to disclose or share your personal data in order to comply with any legal obligation, or in order to enforce or apply our terms of use.

We may share your information with Feefo Holdings Ltd or any other comparable review site for the purpose of providing a review of our services based on your experience with us. We will not provide any personal information on any publicised reviews, and the reviews are conducted primarily for marketing or internal review purposes.

WHERE WE STORE YOUR PERSONAL DATA AND HOW LONG DO WE HOLD IT FOR

Your information is stored electronically within our servers and case management systems. Some of your information is segregated to reduce risk, access is controlled, and our systems are backed up regularly to ensure integrity. Any payment transactions will be encrypted using SSL technology.

We will take all steps reasonably necessary to ensure that your data is treated securely and in accordance with this privacy policy.
